As a reminder to all that play Eagle Crest Resort golf courses:

Neither Eagle Crest, nor the Eagle Crest Men's Golf Club, has adopted the "Model Local Rule E-5" as an alternative to stroke and distance penalties for a lost ball or out of bounds.

If a member is playing in a casual 4-some, and they choose to apply this option, the round should not be posted. The result of posting with Rule E-5 may adversely affect the player's handicap index.

Therefore, it is strongly recommended that the player hit a provisional ball if there is a possibility of a lost ball or a ball out of bounds.

Resort Cup. Congratulations to the Eagle Crest Resort Cup team for their excellent start to the 2020 season. The first of four events were held on the Ridge Course on June 2nd. The top 4 Stableford

scores of our A and B players are counted and the low score of A and B is dropped. Our pro score, Kevin Story for this event, is also counted. A team members were Jay Webber, Rick Bozanich, Todd Jensen, Pat Swope and Dennis Rector. The B team consisted of Ron Cox, Dale Yoakum, George Mead, Monty Knittel and Rob Mahoney.

Our A team players did exceptionally well. The top four scores in the event were identical 38's by Jay Webber, Rick Bozanich, Pat Swope and Dennis Rector. Rob Mahoney led all B event scores with a 40. Dale Yoakum followed with a 37, Ron Cox 34 and Monty Knittel with 31. Kevin Story scored a 36.

The competition will continue in July with a match at Black Butte. Widgi Creek and Sun River will host the Resort Cup later this summer.

Men's Club Championships:

President's Message



Via Dave Miller, Acting President
4 ECMGC members met with Ron B and Kevin S on July 1st. Highlights included:

The new sand for the Resort Course filled 2 train cars and cost \$25K. Bunker work will be completed on the Resort in 2 weeks. More sand will be in the budget for 2023 for the Ridge and Challenge courses. Bunkers are some of the most expensive features on a golf course therefore some bunkers are being modified and some eliminated. The practice bunker at the Ridge driving range is still planned for the fall of 2022 dependent on staffing resources. The practice bunkers will be located east of the lesson area at the Ridge.

The cart path work on the Ridge, on holes #2 though #4, will eliminate many square feet of asphalt to save costs in the long run. The entry to the path at the #2 green, that wasn't re-paved,

will be removed and planted. Hole locations are changed on the courses every Monday and Friday. People that play Monday through Thursday may not be they are changed a twice each week.

The courses are rated by the OGA every six years. Rating takes 2 to 3 weeks. EC is scheduled to be re-rated in 2024

A reminder that credits in the pro shop are not only good for equipment but also for lessons, shoe re-spiking, equipment repair and re-gripping

We asked about the #2 hole at the Resort and putting back the markers telling golfers how far it is to the 150 marker. They'll check into it.

The Resort is instituting a No Fishing policy on all of the lakes and ponds associated with all three courses.

Golf support staffing is in pretty good shape although availability and wages are still a challenge.

Eagle Crest is hosting a number of tournaments this summer and fall. Info will be coming but here's a recap: July 29th will be a two

person, two club tournament at the Challenge Course.

September will see be the First Annual Stroke Play Championship tournament for Eagle Crest affiliated people (to be defined).

October will see the No Wimps tournament and November will have the annual Duck/Beaver tournament.

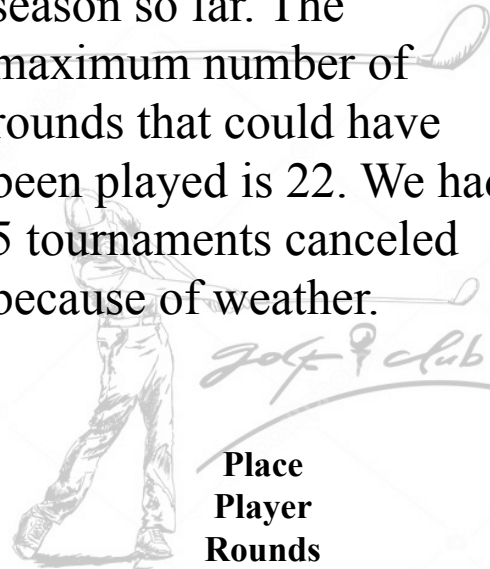

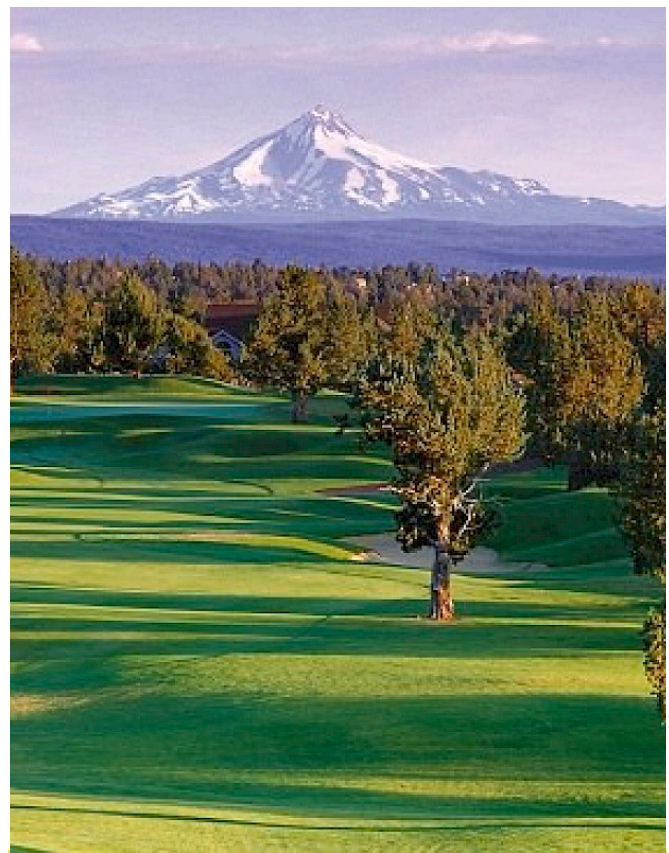


