Resort Course Update

As we are all aware, the Resort Course turf conditions really took a hit last year as a result of COVID (reduced staffing early in the year), hot dry summer and irrigation failure. The Eagle Crest Master Association Board has approved approximately \$30K from the capital improvement fund to retrofit the pumps and install an electricity filter in the pump house. The changes will allow the pumps to function at full capacity and provide the correct amount of water pressure for irrigation, especially on the back nine. The new electricity filter will prevent the pumps from shutting done as they have done in the past during high use times (evenings) which cause a lower power flow. Several trees are being removed and funds were also set aside for sprinkler and controller replacement to improve irrigation coverage. The maintenance crew will be working to improve turf conditions during the coming growing season.

Until the turf has recovered, the BOD for the men's club has determined that lies in the bare patches in the fairway may be treated a ground under repair and you may move your ball to the nearest point of relief, no nearing the hole. If you are not in the fairway, you play the ball as it lies.

The membership committee of the Eagle Crest Men's Goff Club would like to welcome all our membership to the 2021 Golf season at Eagle Crest Resort. The goal of our golf club is to create an enjoyable golf atmosphere for all no matter which of the three courses are being played.

2021 is already a great year!


