Match Play Tournament

June 19th & 20th, 2024

Schedule

Round 1 on the Resort Course will be played on Wednesday, June 19. Round 2 will be played on the Ridge Course on the following day - June 20th.

Following Round 2, all subsequent matches must be completed by July 17th.

Like last year, the tournament will setup a flight of low handicappers, who chose not to play with a handicap, for a chance to win the ECMGC Gross Match Play Championship.

Starting after the 17th, there will be a single-elimination bracket tournament among all flight winners (which finishes no later than July 30) to declare the club's Net Match Play Champion.

Tournament organizers Rob Mahoney (mahoneyrobert@sbcglobal.net) and Reed Sloss (rjsloss5@bendcable.com) will be available to assist with with scheduling and results.

Following Round 2, players may agree on which course to play - Ridge or Resort. If you're not in agreement, toss a coin. Scorecards for Round 3+ will be available at the relevant proshop in advance. Turn in completed scorecards in at the appropriate pro shop.

Double Elimination Format

Players will be assigned an 8-man flight based on their handicap index for the first round of play. Handicaps will be updated daily. Like last year there will be an open flight for golfers playing without a handicap which may be larger than 8 men.

Players advance through their flight (bracket), either in the winners' or losers' brackets, until all but one player in each flight (bracket) is eliminated via two match losses.

Flight winners will ultimately survive via either zero or one loss in all their matches. It is possible for a player to win his flight with one loss (but not with two losses).

Payouts

Payouts will be based on match wins (as shown in a separate handout) with amounts increasing along progression through both winners' and losers' brackets.
