The following is provided for current and future members of the Eagle Crest Men's Golf Club (hereinafter referred to as ECMGC):

MEMBERSHIP VISION

TO APPEAL TO, ENCOURAGE, OBTAIN AND RETAIN OPTIMUM MEMBERSHIP IN THE ECMGC REGARDLESS OF PLAYING ABILITY

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- * Membership in the ECMGC is open to anyone. Residing in Eagle Crest is not a prerequisite or requirement.
- * Current or new members may be members of other golf course organizations.
- * All skill level players are welcome to join. However, all members must purchase and maintain a current personal Handicap Index (GHIN) through the Oregon Golf Association (OGA).
 - Note: For new members moving into the area, a GHIN held from another state may be used until the new handicap year.
- * Once a member, a player is always considered a member as long as his annual dues are current. 2024 annual dues of \$50.00 must be paid before any participation in events and will not be prorated. Dues are payable by January 31, 2024 and are set by the ECMGC Board of Directors annually based on current economic conditions.

MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

- * Members realize the social and competitive advantages of a 'country club' atmosphere. Camaraderie of over 100 members is enjoyed year-round.
- * Members may compete in all ECMGC sponsored events, tournaments and outings. Fees and requirements vary from event to event, and each member is responsible for compliance.
- * Members have the opportunity to play in the four (4) major competitive tournaments sponsored by Eagle Crest Resort and the ECMGC; EC CUP, MATCH PLAY, CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP and THE FALL CLASSIC. Note: The EC CUP, MATCH PLAY and CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP require all participants to have played at least five (5) rounds of stipulated play (within the ECMGC) prior to the week of their being played.
- * The ECMGC uses the on-line program GOLF GENIUS. Members enjoy the ease of scheduling, notifications, and event results, thus cutting down on excessive email and electronic clutter.
- * All member earnings are electronically saved and may only be used in either the Ridge or Resort Course Pro Shops.

MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

- * Members have the option to choose the appropriate playing package offered by the Eagle Crest Golf Courses. This is independent of the ECMGC.
- * Members may purchase a Hole in One insurance policy from the ECMGC (\$15.00) for Wednesday events and the Ryder Cup and Match Play and Club Championship.
- * Members may compete in Home and Home events with other golf courses. Additionally, members may compete (either by qualification, invitation, or selection) in the Resort Cup Competition.
- * Members are eligible to participate in the annual Eagle Crest Ladies Club tournament Mixer.
